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Abdominal Ultrasound

Indication Recurrent abdominal pain.

Liver 2 cm cyst, round, circumscribed, thin-walled, anechoic structure producing posterior

enhancement Right upper lobe near diaphragm.

Length 16.7 cm, Width 17.4 cm.

Gallbladder proper position, normal size, sludge, 1 cm stone detected.

Length 5.2 cm, Thickness of gallbladder wall 1.7 mm.

Bile Ducts intra- and extrahepatic bile ducts not dilated, no stone detected, no intraluminal lesion

detected.

Pancreas WNL where visualized.

Spleen normal size, homogeneous, no focal lesions, clear hilum.

Length 4.3 cm, Width 2.0 cm, Height 5.5 cm, Volume 24.8 cm³.

Right Kidney orthotopic positon, normal size, normal shape, no urine retention detected, no stones

detected.

Length 10.0 cm, Width 6.0 cm, Height 4.0 cm, Volume 125.7 cm³.

Left Kidney orthotopic positon, normal size, normal shape, no urine retention detected, no stones

detected.

Length 11.3 cm, Width 7.5 cm, Height 4.2 cm, Volume 186.4 cm³.

Bladder normal size, wall without pathological findings, no intraluminal lesion detected.

Abdominal Within normal limits.

Aorta

Impression One 2 cm simple cyst seen in the right lobe of the liver.

One 1cm stone visualized in the gallbladder with a small amount of sludge.

Otherwise Normal abdomen ultrasound.
